

CAMP Kipwe

FACT SHEET

'Kipwe' meaning blessed in Swahili, is nestled in the boulders, facing out onto superb scenery. Incorporating the red basalt rocks and mopane branches, it has a natural organic feel. Great care has been taken with the design of the recreational areas, giving the impression of an African Village.

LOCATION:

GPS: 20°32'17.60"S 14°25'47.30"E

Camp Kipwe is located in the Uibasen-Twyfelfontein Community Conservancy in Damaraland. This is in the north-eastern region with the closest towns being Uis, approximately 122km south and Khorixas approximately 92km east.

Windhoek is 550km and is approximately 5 ½ hours' drive, Swakopmund is 320km and is approximately 4 ½ hours' drive. Transfers from Twyfelfontein Airstrip are approximately 20 minutes.

ACCESS:

Closest International Airports are Walvis Bay International Airport - 360km and Hosea Kutako International Airport, Windhoek - 590km

Closest Airstrip - Twyfelfontein, 15km

BEST TIME TO GO & WEATHER:

All year round is a great time to travel to this area! Always pack for hot & cold conditions all year round.

Midsummer temperatures can rise to approximately 38°C. In winter daytime temperatures can vary between 18-25°C while at night and in the morning, it can drop to below freezing.

The rainy season is from October/November through to March, however this area receives minimal rainfall and rain seldom lasts more than an hour or two at most.

LODGE FACILITIES:

- Solar geysers and electricity with back-up generator. Plugs run on 220/240 volts. Outlets are round 3-pin 15-amp type, or 2 round-pin plugs

Accommodation:

9 X BUNGALOWS:

Twin bedded accommodation (can be converted to a Double bed) in the shape of rondavels with air-conditioning and limited Wi-Fi. These rooms feature a verandah area and private en-suite, open-air bathroom tucked into the rocks (outdoor shower and ablutions).

1 X KIPWE SUITE

The air-conditioned, elevated thatched suite is a tented retreat with a spacious deck, heated splash pool and shaded sala. It features a private lounge equipped with satellite television, a stocked minibar and limited Wi-Fi. The bedroom offers a king-size bed and en-suite, open air bathroom with a large bath. Laundry service included for stays of 2 nights or more.

2 X LUXURY SUITES (East and West Facing):

Both luxury thatched suites are elevated and feature a large lounge with separate air-conditioned bedroom, and en-suite bathroom before spilling out on to a large deck with spectacular, uninterrupted views. The suites are equipped with limited Wi-Fi, a stocked minibar, heated splash pool and private salas. Private dining and laundry included for stays of 2 nights or longer.

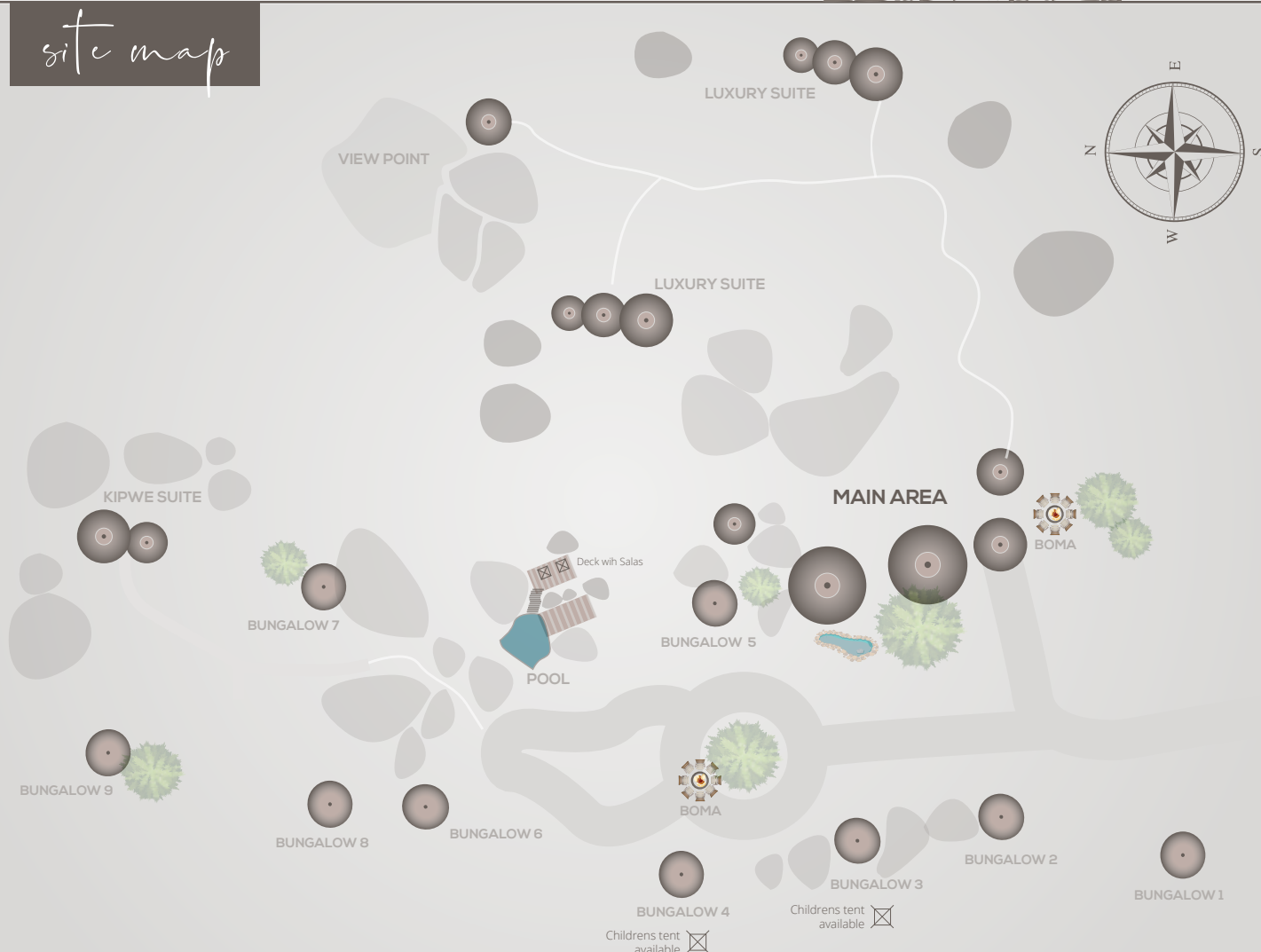

ACTIVITIES:

- **Guided Nature Drive** – Usually departs at 06h30 and will go out for +/- 4 – 6 hours to explore the surrounding area and search for desert adapted animals, such as the desert-adapted elephants. Drinks & snacks are included.
- **Twyfelfontein, Burnt Mountain and Organ Pipes Excursion** - this usually departs at 15h00 and will last for +/- 2 hours taking in the famous UNESCO World Heritage Site of Twyfelfontein to explore the rock engravings, along with seeing Burnt Mountain and the Organ Pipes.
- **Damara Living Museum** - guests are transported to the museum to learn about the traditional lifestyle, crafts, customs, and practices of the Damara people, while also engaging with them as they live today.
- **Self- Guided Nature Walk – Available at Mowani Mountain Camp (4km away).** Guests are free to follow the short walking trail with information showing the names of different plants and trees on their own (or, depending on guide's availability they are welcome to ask the guides to take them on a longer walk.)

FAMILIES AND CHILDREN:

Camp Kipwe is child friendly.
Children under the age of 3 stay free of charge.
Children aged 3 - 12 are accommodated in a children's tent or on camping beds in the room with their parents at a special child rate.

Please note that Camp Kipwe have a limited number of camping beds. Parents are kindly requested to ensure their children behave accordingly as other guests need to be taken into consideration, especially on activities and when in the main dining and lounge area. Please note that there are snakes and scorpions in the area and the lodge is surrounded by boulders so parents need to make sure that their children do not put their hands in little nooks and crannies, and do not climb, jump and leap on the boulders.

Special meal times and food preferences are to be advised in advance for adequate preparations to be made to accommodate the requests.

RATES:

All rates are quoted in Namibian Dollars (N\$).
Included are accommodation, breakfast, dinner, NTB Tourism Levy & VAT.
Excluded are the activities, lunch, drinks, curios and items of a personal nature.
