CONSERVATION RIDE SAMPLE ITINERARY

A ride of a lifetime on horseback, across an ecosystem which is at the forefront of wildlife conservation. Spend your days exploring the valleys and hills which form some of the best riding country in Africa.

With Mt. Kenya on the horizon, weave between elephant and rhino, cross river beds and grass plains; all the while staying in luxurious camps under the stars and comfortable safari lodges.

ITINERARY

This trip takes place on Borana Conservancy and Il Ngwesi Group Ranch; both are home to Black and White Rhino. Each day will include at least 6 hours of horse riding and will be fully hosted and guided.

DAY 1

Arrive in Nairobi, fly to Lewa Downs airstrip. Night at Borana Lodge.

DAY 2

Begin your adventure with a day on Borana Conservancy, exploring Kenya's newest and most successful Rhino sanctuary. Night at Borana Lodge.

DAY 3

Enjoy your first full day on horseback as you cross Borana Conservancy to a luxurious fly camp. Night under canvas.

DAYS 4 & 5

Leave Borana Conservancy and ride across to Il Ngwesi Group Ranch, a successful community run conservation area. Enjoy horse riding through dry river beds and walking safaris. Two nights at Il Ngwesi Lodge.

DAY 6

Depart Il Ngwesi Eco Lodge to spend the day riding through the Mukogodo Forest, where the elusive forest elephant live. Night under canvas.

DAY 7

A final full day of riding across Western Borana Conservancy. Night at Borana Lodge.

DAY 8

Return to Nairobi.



This itinerary will give you the opportunity to traverse some of Kenya's most breathtaking landscapes. Along this journey you will be given the chance to learn about various conservation models, as well as take part in the 'behind the scenes of conservation' activities offered by Borana Lodge.
