GETTING TO NANZHILA

Although Nanzhila is remote, it's **not hard to get to!** We have a road transfer agent **based in Livingstone** who can get you to the park gate in **about 3 hours**. Alternatively, we can fly you into the park with a charter flight from Livingstone or Lusaka. The lodge GPS co-ordinates are: **S16°16' 45" E25°56'04"**.





ACCOMMODATION

3 en-suite safari tents and 3 en-suite chalets complimented by a perfectly positioned main 'insaka' lodge complete with boma, fireplace, deck and bar!



3 tents in total. 1 x Queen bed safari tent and 2 x 3/4 bed safari tents. All en-suite.



3 chalets in total. 1 x Queen bed chalet and 2 x 3/4 bed chalets. All en-suite.

OTHER ESSENTIAL INFORMATION

MEALS & DRINKS	Meals are offered as delicious, wholesome "home-style" experiences while local drinks are included in the fully inclusive package. Imported and premium brands are additional.
ACTIVITIES	Game drives, bush walks, visits to the waterholes and hides, sundowners and the "Kafue Explorer" are all offered in the fully inclusive rate.
CLIMATE & CLOTHING	Clothing should be cool and comfortable. Jerseys and anoraks will be required in the evenings and early mornings during the winter months
ACCESSORIES	Bring sunscreen, sunglasses, a hat, binoculars and camera. The lodge supplies torches and insect repellent.
HEALTH	Malaria is present and it is advisable to take the necessary precautions prior to visiting the area.
COMMUNICATIONS	No cellphone reception but satellite internet communications and a satellite phone are available for emergencies
ELECTRICITY	Solar power with provisions to charge cameras, laptops and phones. 3 prong round plug point system.
GRATUITIES	Gratuities are at a client's discretion. A guideline is USD 10 per day for guides and USD 10 per day to cover all camp staff
LAUNDRY	laundry service is offered covering essential items
VISA REQUIREMENTS	Tourist visas are required for non-SADC clients and cost \$50 per person on arrival in Zambia. No visa required for SADC
